

Bingo Instructions

Ask the students “How are these bingo cards different or the same as the Bingo game you know?” Explain that this game has pictures of marine life/river life rather than numbers in each square. The caller will pick a card and say the name of the beach /river animal or plant on the card. If you have the plant or animal on your card, mark it with a clam shell or some other nature marker (mussel shell, rock, tree cone etc.)



BINGO directions – make sure the game boards have sea creatures in different places. Children playing BINGO need to have a variety of boards – creating more chances for children to “win”.
